BOTANICAL NAME

Habitat/Ecology

Open eucalyptus forests over hummock grasslands on hills. Serpentine soils on gravelly slopes and ridges. EPBC listing as 'Vulnerable'.

Home use

A fast growing, hardy, attractive ornamental plant suitable for cut foliage.

Habit

Multi-stemmed shrub 1-3 m tall; resprouts from base.

Flowers/Fruit

Flowers: deep yellow to greenish yellow; May-Sept.
Seed: 18-25 mm long.

Leaves/Stems

Branchlets & young leaves: covered with soft brown hair.

Propagation

Seeds, no pre-treatment; germinates in 3-12 weeks.

Water/Shade

Drought and frost tolerant once established; partial to deep shade.

Maintenance

Well drained to poorly drained soil (avoid very wet).
